

## VISAS

### European Students

If you are a national of one of the following countries\*, you do not need to apply for a visa. You can travel to Spain with your national identity card and/or your passport: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Norway, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, United Kingdom, Czech Republic, Romania, Sweden and Switzerland.

Once you are in Spain and you start classes at the University, it will be necessary to apply for a **Certificate of Registration of Citizens of the Union** at the Foreigners Office of Coruña <http://www.coruna.gal/portal/es/detalle/oficina-de-extranjeros-de-a-coruna/entidad/1149055885837?argIdioma=es> which will include your Foreign Identity Number (NIE), your identification number during your stay in Spain.

\* If you have double European nationality and a passport issued by a European country, it will not be necessary to apply for a student visa, as you will be a European citizen. The information for European students will apply.
